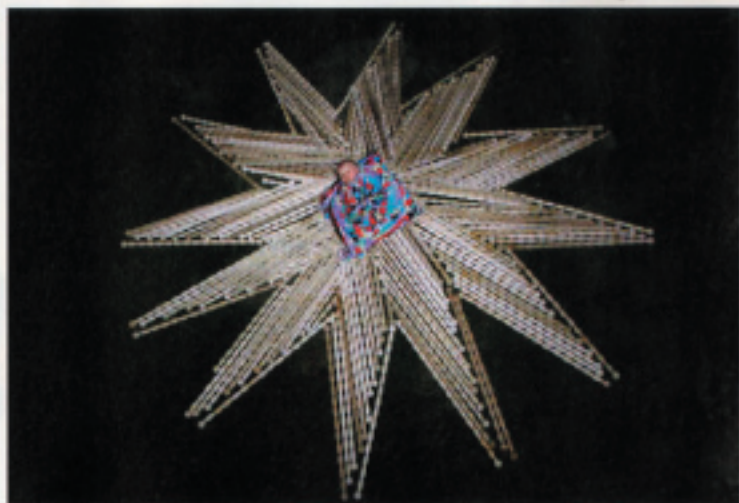


AMERICAN EYE ^

It's the 50th anniversary of *The Americans* – Robert Frank's photography collection culled from the 28,000 photos he took on a road trip around the States from 1955-1956. Publishers Steidl are reissuing the contemporary masterpiece along with the original introduction from Jack Kerouac. *The Americans* broke boundaries when it was published in 1959, and has won iconic status as the portrait of the lonely side of the world's richest country. Frank showed things that had never been photographed before – barren roadsides, the forlorn gazes of bored waitresses, a baby next to a coffin-like jukebox, the long shadow of a kid in a narrow corridor of light between a bus and a skyscraper. All of it explores the vast dislocation of America, echoing Swiss-born Frank's outsider's perspective. Now in his 90s, Frank sums up the mini-tragedy of the banal that he captures in his photos. "Life can be good, then you lie down, and stare up at the ceiling," he says. "Then the sadness falls on you." *AL*
